Why a syndicate?

Syndicates can be a great way to play the lottery. They offer:

- More chances to win
- Buy tickets with friends and colleagues

Step by step guide

- 1. Choose a syndicate manager
- 2. Everyone signs the syndicate agreement (there's a blank agreement included at the end of this document)
- 3. The syndicate manager signs up for the tickets collecting monies from syndicate members as/when is appropriate
- 4. That's it. You're now safely playing as a syndicate

Questions?

Q: What does a syndicate manager do?

A: The syndicate manager is responsible for:

- Owning the account that buys the tickets
- Collecting funds from syndicate members
- Making sure the Syndicate Agreement is up to date
- Letting the syndicate know if/when they win

Q: How do we buy tickets?

A: The syndicate manager buys the tickets online via the site. Paying by either Direct Debit or debit card.

Q: Is there a maximum number of people or tickets?

A: There is no maximum number of people in a syndicate or a maximum number of tickets.

Q: Do we need to register our syndicate with you?

A: No the syndicate manager will play online like any other player. There is no need to let us know that they represent a syndicate.
